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**ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION AND REINSTATING
MEDICATION TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE**

On or about April 2, 2020, the Maryland Board of Nursing (the “Board”) issued a “Final Order of Suspension of Medication Technician Certificate for Delinquent Child Support” (“Order of Suspension”), suspending the medication technician certificate “MT” of **DAJUAN BROWN**, certificate number **MT0095596** (the “Respondent”). Pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Family Law (“Fam. Law”) § 10.119.3 (e)(2)(i) (2012 Repl. Vol.), upon request of the Baltimore City Office of Child Support Enforcement Administration of the Maryland Department of Human Resources (the “Administration”), the Board suspended the Respondent’s certificate to practice as a Medication Technician in the State of Maryland due to the Respondent’s delinquent support payments for Child Support Enforcement Administration Case Number **530134158**.

On March 1, 2022, the Board received a “Notice of Compliance” from the Administration for Case Number 530134158. Pursuant to the Maryland Nurse Practice Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. (“Health Occ.”) §§ 8-319(a), the Respondent otherwise qualifies for an MT certificate.

Therefore, pursuant to section 10-119.3(k) of the Family Law Article, on this 2nd day of March, 2022, by the Maryland Board of Nursing, it is

ORDERED that the suspension of the Respondent’s certificate to practice as a medication technician, certificate number **MT0095596**, in the State of Maryland is hereby **LIFTED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the certificate of the Respondent to practice as a medication technician, certificate number **MT0095596**, is **REINSTATED** without restrictions; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland Board of Nursing and, as such, is a **PUBLIC RECORD** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. § 4-101 *et seq.* (2014).
