MultiState Licensing

There are now a total of 13 states in the Multi-State Licensure Compact. The most recent additions are Maine, Mississippi and Iowa.

Mrs. Dorsey reported on a meeting of the Committee. She has been invited to join the group along with the Executive Directors of the Board of Pharmacy and the Board of Physician Quality Assurance. This group has a legislative mandate to assess what is being done in the state to reduce medical errors and develop solutions that provide for patient safety. The first activity is to survey regulators and providers to determine what initiatives are in place. This should be completed by the end of September. The Board's PREP program is such an initiative.
